We provide an environment that is:

Fun: We want everyone to love dance. We structure the classes and select both movement and music to help make learning fun, while being age-appropriate.

Safe: Our staff is well-trained to instruct movement that is safe for our students' developing bodies. We teach and correct for proper form in all types of classes.

Affordable: We want dance to be available for everyone. We encourage you to compare our prices to others in the area; you will find that we are extremely competitive.

We strive for excellence in:

Faculty/Teaching: With 60 plus years of training and over 40 years of instruction between the two of us, we select our faculty carefully to ensure that our students receive the same high quality of instruction in all classes. Our teachers are encouraged to continue their dance education, maintaining their own flexibility and performance levels, and learning new techniques and styles for use in their classes.

Performance: In June, our students perform in a professional-quality recital that is set on a stage with costumes, music, and lighting design. The performance showcases all of the hard work that our students have done throughout the year.

Though our focus is not on competitive dance, we do have select advanced classes that have participated in a few carefully chosen competitions. Our dancers have scored very well in comparison to the other studios, taking home an array of honors. With the foundation that we have given them, some of our graduated seniors have gone on to pursue dance study and performance groups in college as well.

Lynn Moniz – co-owner and teacher

Instructing dance in Arlington & Lexington for over 23 years, Lynn is a certified member of the Dance Teachers Club of Boston, an affiliate of the American Dance Teachers Club. She teaches jazz, combo, and creative movement classes.

Jennifer Wesley Corbett – co-owner and teacher

A BFA graduate of NYU's Tisch School of the Arts, Jennifer developed her own signature movement style through her work with several established New York choreographers. She teaches modern, ballet, and combo classes.

A current member of the Jose Mateo Theatre, with a BFA in Ballet Performance from the University of the Arts in Philadelphia, Reco brings his love of ballet and professional experience to class.

Betzi Hanc – ballet/tap combo teacher

With a BA degree in dance from UMass Amherst, Betzi shares her joy for dance and the fun in learning with our young dancers.

Christine Masci – jazz teacher

An alumna of our studio and a 2006 – 2007 Patriots cheerleader, Christine shares her energy, personal flare and contemporary jazz choreography with her students.

Courtney O'Brien – creative movement and tap teacher

Instructing dance for all ages in the Somerville area for more than 19 years, Courtney's students and choreography have received numerous awards in regional and national championships.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Little Dance Explorers: This toddler class, with a parent or care giver, meets in 6 weeks sessions for 45 minutes per week. This fun exploration of dance uses toddler and instrumental music, musical instruments and props.

Creative Movement: A beginning class for very young children, based on song and dance, this 45 minute class introduces the very first basic steps in the ballet vocabulary, and may introduce tap in the Spring.

Ballet & Tap Combo: The next progression for young dancers, this 1 hour class teaches both ballet fundamentals and basic tap rhythms.

Ballet, Jazz, & Tap Combo: Moving to the next level of advancement, this 2-2 ½ hour (depending on a child's age and previous dance experience) class builds the basic ballet and tap steps into combinations, and adds in jazz dance.

Hip Hop: This 45 minute class is great for both experienced and inexperienced dancers (no previous dance training is required). Students learn movement that has a much more natural, "street" feeling. The class is just good fun!

Ballet: As the dancers become more advanced, ballet becomes its own 1-1 ½ hour class (depending on student's level). The style we teach is contemporary, with a Balanchine influence – clean and safe technique, graceful movements, agility, and emotion.

Ballet Technique: This 1 ½ hour class helps to strengthen dancers by focusing on technical proficiency. Dancers have the opportunity to advance and perfect their body alignment, flexibility, and focus. This class does not perform a dance in the recital.

Jazz: Progressing to the full 1 hour, these classes are also more contemporary, introducing popular video dance to Broadway styles of jazz movement.

Tap: This 45 min-1 hour (depending on age and level) class incorporates tapping with a jazzy movement style, using musical & harmonious rhythms.

Contemporary / Modern: Only available for our older students this 1-1 ½ hour class uses a contemporary, ballet-influenced modern movement repertory that produces a very physical dance which includes floor work, complex footwork, and flight.
